Conference idea

Full papers should be submitted using the online form on the Conference website www.met2022.tu.kielce.pl. Each paper will be peer-reviewed by at least two members of the Scientific Committee. Due to time limitations, only selected papers will be qualified for presentation in scientific sessions.
